Kameran Onley leads the Conservancy's engagement with Congress, Federal agencies, and partners to achieve the Conservancy's marine conservation goals as the world's largest science-based ocean conservation organization. Prior to joining the Nature Conservancy, Onley served as Associate Vice President with PBS&J, Inc. where she lead projects for the Department of the Interior (DOI) and National Oceanographic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) in the management of restoration of national resources. She has also held positions as the acting Assistant Secretary for Water and Science at DOI, Associate Director for Environmental Policy at the White House Council on Environmental Quality, Associate Director for the Regulatory Studies Program at the Mercatus Center, and Manager for Environmental Policy Issues for Koch Industries and the Charles G. Koch Charitable Foundation.
